PUBLIC HEARING - SPECIAL MEETING

The Lexington City Council met in a Public Hearing – Special Meeting on Monday, August 26, 2024, at 5:00 p.m., at City Hall, 604 Wheatley, Lexington, Texas.

Present was Mayor Allen Retzlaff, Councilpersons Dale Phelps, Bobby Wesner, David Mason and Anthony Retzlaff.

Public Hearing

Mayor Retzlaff brought the Public Hearing to order and welcomed the guests.

- 2. The City of Lexington held a Public Hearing to consider adoption of the 2024-2025 budget. This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by an estimated \$17,074 (3.49%), and of that amount \$4,574 is tax revenue to be raised from estimated new property added to the tax roll this year. No public comments. Hearing ended at 5:01 p.m.
- 3. David Mason made the motion to adopt the **proposed** tax rate of 0.3939 for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2024 and ending September 30, 2025. Anthony Retzlaff seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.

- 5. Anthony Retzlaff made the motion to table setting rates for customers with 2" water meters. Bobby Wesner seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.
- 6. Anthony Retzlaff made the motion to raise rates for commercial sewer customers from \$21.35 to \$22.35 and add \$1. per tier on the rate chart effective October 1, 2024. Bobby Wesner seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.
- 7. Anthony Retzlaff made the motion to approve the Contract for Services with the Lee County Tax Office. Dale Phelps seconded the motion. Vote 4 for.
- 8. Dale Phelps made the motion to adjourn. David Mason seconded the motion. Vote 4 for. The meeting was adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
